

## Thomasville Community Resource Center 2020-2021 School Year:

To our families, we know you have been wondering; with everything that is going on; how we will deal with COVID-19 and enrollment. TCRC has worked hard to coordinate with the schools to ensure the safety of our students as we transition into the 2020-2021 school year. This letter will serve as a guide as to how our sites will be set up. After careful consideration all our sites will begin August 10, 2020 when all schools are in session. Please keep in mind that this plan is subject to change based on school district decisions.

Students must be enrolled in traditional school to attend TCRC After school sites. Transportation will be provided to after school sites. Students must wear a mask on the bus, entering, and leaving the building. We realize masks are required in school, but we will also have masks in the event one is needed. All applications have a \$25 Reg Fee per family, (we no longer accept checks, money order, etc; all payments are electronic) all applications will be handled in the order we receive them; once all classes are filled other applications received will be placed on Waitlist.
